Girls in Action (GAs): The Girls in Action (GAs) program is designed to introduce girls in 1st – 6th grades to mission work. The primary focus is on six areas of missions: praying for missions, engaging in mission action and witnessing, learning about missions, supporting missions, developing spiritually toward a missions lifestyle, and participating in the work of the church and the denomination. Each month girls study a specific mission area. They pray for missionaries and missionary kids. They may also participate in Live Action Projects-ministry projects that are designed to help GAs understand and reach out to meet the needs of others. Girls learn how to share their faith in practical and exciting ways. GAs learn about missionaries who serve at home and around the world and how they are sharing the good news of Jesus with people from many different cultures. They will learn from the stories how they can share the love of Jesus with their friends, family and community. Royal Ambassadors (RAs): The Royal Ambassadors (RAs) program is a Bible-centered missions-learning ministry for boys in grades K-7. The ministry involves boys in learning about missions through weekly meetings, mission projects, and fellowship activities, where they learn about the love of Christ and building relationships with each other. Boys in grades K-3 are Lads, and those in grades 4-7 are Crusaders. The RA Motto is “We Are Ambassadors for Christ.” (2 Cor. 5:20) and the boys make a commitment to live out that motto by learning how missionaries go out into communities both in the United States and around the world and share the love of Christ. They are encouraged to find their unique place in God’s mission of spreading the gospel message. Each month we also emphasize, through study and activities, parts of the RA Pledge and one of the RA virtues of Loyalty, Faith, Courage, Friendship, Responsibility, Honesty, Perseverance, Self Discipline and Teamwork.
